



Privacy Policy Notice:

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers (legislation) the right to limit some but not all sharing of information. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. This notice is being provided pursuant thereby.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number or taxpayer identification number
- Home address or e-mail address
- Assets, income and financial information

When you are no longer our customer, we may still share your information as described herein.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to delivery everyday service. In the following matrix section, we list some, but not all of the, reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons they choose to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Innova protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Innova collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you open an account or invest or deposit or withdraw money.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
Non-affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
Other important information
